Rawe Foundation gives to children's center

The Northern Kentucky Children's Advocacy Center (NKYCAC) in Florence is the recipient of a \$7,500 gift for the third year in a row from the Albert S. and Anna L. Rawe Family Foundation.

Funds will allow the center to continue providing trauma mental health services for children of abuse.

"We are so grateful once again to the Rawe family for this very important and special gift," said NKYCAC Executive Director Vickie Henderson. "Providing mental health support to children after the horrors they have endured from abuse is an essential part of the healing process.

In addition to NKYCAC, the Brighton Center and the Diocesan Catholic Children's Home Center for Children and Families have also received donations. The Foundation has raised and contributed \$77,000 since 2017 by hosting a fundraiser at Hickory Sticks Golf Club in Campbell County and a sand volleyball tournament.
